As at 1<sup>st</sup> October 2024, Te Ara Ahunga Ora Retirement Commission has 39 full and part-time employees, including one on parental leave.


2. *The number of directly employed staff and their positions who earn less than \$27.80 per hour (excluding all allowances or overtime rates).*
